Partnership Objectives:


- Increase access to baccalaureate degree programs

- Strengthen the partnership between Wingate University and Rowan-Cabarrus Community College


Requirements:


- Complete the degree requirements at Rowan-Cabarrus Community College for an Associate in Science (AS), Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Fine Arts (AFA), Associate in Arts in Teacher Preparation (AATP), Associate in Science in Teacher Preparation (ASTP), *Associate in Engineering (AE), and Associate in Applied Science (AAS). *Wingate does not offer an engineering degree, but accepts the Associate in Engineering as a transfer degree for students interested in other STEM fields.
- Complete the FAFSA or Financial Responsibility Form
- Prior to enrolling at Wingate, students must submit a Wingate University admissions application by the specified deadline, send Wingate official transcripts from RCCC, and meet Wingate transfer admissions requirements. There is no application fee.
- To register for classes at Wingate, students must submit an enrollment deposit and complete required items on the deposited student checklist by the specified deadline.
- For students currently enrolled at RCCC, it is strongly recommended to participate in academic advising and faculty mentoring sessions with both RCCC and WU academic advisors to ensure appropriate course selection and matriculation for seamless and efficient transfer
