Provides postlicensing instruction in broker responsibilities relating to real estate sales contracts, contract procedures, the Real Estate Settlement Procedure Act and closings. Topics include contract law concepts, residential sales contract preparation and procedures, closing procedures and closing statement preparation.

Provides postlicensing instruction in broker relationships and responsibilities when working with residential sellers and buyers. Topics include agency relationships and duties, agency contracts and disclosure and the practical aspects of working with residential buyers and sellers.

NC Law, Rules, and Legal Concepts 8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m.

Topics addressed in this course include commercial real estate brokerage, residential property management, land use controls, loan fraud, license law issues and case studies, fair housing, establishing a brokerage firm, and manufactured and modular homes.
