



BASIC RIDER COURSE MOTORCYCLE SAFETY

Rowan-Cabarrus Community College, in collaboration with the NC Motorcycle Safety Foundation, is proud to sponsor driver education courses on both 2-wheel and 3-wheel motorcycles. Rider coaches have been trained and certified by the NC Motorcycle Safety Foundation to conduct both 2- and 3-wheel courses, which consists of both classroom instruction and hands-on riding exercises, including a knowledge and skills test.

UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE COURSES, YOU WILL BE ISSUED A SKILLS WAIVER CARD FOR THE NCDMV.

2-WHEEL COURSE

Sponsored by the North Carolina Motorcycle Safety Education Program, this course teaches the skills needed to operate a two-wheel motorcycle. The class is designed for new riders who have never ridden a motorcycle, and for re-entry riders who have not ridden in a long time. However, experienced riders have also found it to be quite beneficial.

Requirements: You do not need to possess a driver's license or learner's permit to take this 3-Day course. The first day of this class is an eCourse which will be conducted 100% ONLINE! You will meet face-to-face on Days 2 and 3 for a combination of classroom and driving range training.

3-WHEEL COURSE

This is a basic, entry-level, learn-to-ride 3-wheel motorcycle training and education course. It provides the same fundamental skills as the MSF Basic Rider Course, but on a 3-wheel, 3-track motorcycle (not sidecars). The class is designed for new or experienced riders who wish to gain skills operating a 3-wheel motorcycle.

Requirements: You do not need to possess a driver's license or learner's permit to take this 2-Day course. There is no eCourse requirement.
