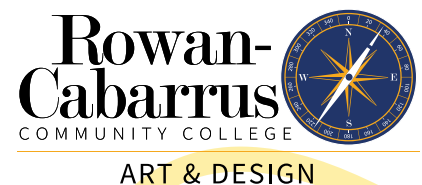

Guidelines:

- **Selection of Work:** Students may submit up to five (5) pieces of artwork for consideration. All five (5) submissions may not be hung if virtual space is not available and all submissions must meet presentation guidelines.

- **Exhibition Dates:** Selected artworks will be exhibited at the virtual exhibition space (link will be sent out November 16th). The exhibition will be open to view online going forward.

- **Fee:** There is no entry fee.

- **Selling Artwork:** Participants may sell their work without a commission (sales will be made directly between student and buyer).

- **Submission Deadlines: The Entry Form and Artwork(s) must be submitted no later than 5:00pm on Thursday November 5th, 2020.** The Entry Form may be submitted online using the provided form at <https://airtable.com/shr3Y4ci3pWereC6Z>. For any questions or complications with the entry form, please send an e-mail to debora.koo@rccc.edu. The Artwork(s) must be delivered by the student for professional documentation to North Campus Room 704 in the 700 Building or to South Campus Room 3233 in the 3000 Building during November 10th to November 11th between 9:00am-4:00pm. Student must arrange a time and date to drop off work(s) by e-mailing debora.koo@rccc.edu (for South Campus drop-off) or jonathan.hoffman@rccc.edu (for North Campus drop-off). *Students are NOT ALLOWED TO ENTER the buildings. Please wait outside or in your vehicle when dropping off all artwork. If artwork is a digital submission, no scheduled drop-off is required but student will send a high quality resolution image under instructor's guidance. Labels must be printed and attached to all submitted artwork (Name, Title of Artwork, Medium, Year, and Price if available). Incomplete submissions will not be considered for exhibition.

- **Collection of Artwork at the End of Documentation:** Students are responsible for picking up their artwork from room 704 (700 Building) on North Campus either Tuesday November 17th or Wednesday November 18th. Work not picked up by November 18th will need to be arranged to be picked up with Jon Hoffman (jonathan.hoffman@rccc.edu) or else it will become the property of Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.

- **Liability:** Participants submit work at their own risk. Artwork is not insured for damage or theft during drop-off, exhibition, or pick-up. Rowan-Cabarrus Community College is not responsible for lost, damaged, stolen, or compromised artwork.

Submission of Artwork Guidelines:

- All submitted work must have been created by the artist **after** August 1st, 2019.

- Submitted work cannot have been previously exhibited.

- All fine art mediums are encouraged (including performance, graphic design, video, etc.).

- There is no size requirement.

- All types of art are encouraged. This includes both 2D and 3D work.

- Work that does not meet the guidelines, will not be included in the show.

- When submitting your artwork on the online entry form, make sure that your photo is an accurate presentation of your actual work. While your art for entry does not have to be professionally photographed, for jurying purposes, we suggest that students request guidance from their art instructor and make sure image(s) is cropped to the artwork edges and shot at a straight angle with good lighting. Note that student work will be professionally documented once accepted into the show.

Important Dates:

- **Submission Opens:** Friday, October 23rd

- **Submission Closes:** Thursday, November 5th 5:00pm

- **November 10th - November 11th between 9:00am-4:00pm:** All Artwork must be delivered to North Campus Room 704 (700 Building, North Campus) or South Campus Room 3233 (3000 Building, South Campus) for professional documentation. Student must arrange a date and time for drop off by e-mailing debora.koo@rccc.edu (for South Campus drop-off) or jonathan.hoffman@rccc.edu (for North Campus drop-off). Students are not allowed to enter the building and must wait outside or in vehicle. Labels must be attached to each artwork/entry. If artwork is a digital submission, no scheduled drop-off is required but student will send a high quality resolution image under instructor's guidance.

- **Thursday November 19th from 5:00pm - 7:00pm:** Opening Reception on Zoom Live with Student Talks!!!! Free and open to the public! Plan to attend!

- **Starting November 16th:** Exhibition open to the public. Admission is FREE! Zoom Link will be provided!!

- **Collection of Artwork at the End of Documentation:** Students are responsible for picking up their artwork from room 704 (700 Building) on North Campus. Students schedule a time to pick up work from North Campus by e-mailing jonathan.hoffman@rccc.edu. Any time after this they will have to notify and schedule beforehand. Work not picked up by the end of the semester will become the property of Rowan-Cabarrus Community College.
